

Zehnder's Splash Village COVID-19 Response

Waterpark

To promote a safe environment for both our guests and our employees we will be implementing these procedures in the Waterpark at Zehnder's Splash Village.

Maintaining Healthy Environments:

- Staff will be cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched surfaces before the park opens and at a minimum of every hour. This is including but not limited to:
 - Handrails, slides, and structures for climbing or playing
 - Lounge chairs, tabletops, tubes, and chairs.
 - Lockers
 - Door handles and surfaces of restrooms (showers, toilets, sinks, etc).
 - First aid room
- Lifejackets will be checked in and out at a staffed table and sanitized after returned.
- Towels will no longer be self-serve but handed out at a staffed table.
- Water chemical levels will be checked and documented every 3 hours.
- All of the water in the waterpark passes through a UV light filtration system to assist with killing harmful viruses and bacteria. Chlorine is also an effective virus and bacteria killing agent and chlorine levels are monitored every three hours.
- Seating will be arranged to allow for appropriate physical distancing between parties.
- Each lifeguard will be assigned one rescue tube per shift. Lifeguards are responsible for sanitizing their rescue tube at the end of their shift.

Splash Park Slides

- Allow only 2 guests at top of slide tower at a time. Guests waiting will be monitored to ensure social distancing.
- Eliminate double tubes using only single tubes on the Four-Story tube slides cutting ridership in half.

Atrium Park Slides

- Allow only 3 guests at top of slide tower at a time. Guests waiting will be monitored to ensure social distancing.
- Drop slide remains as it is at one person per slide.
- Family raft ride cut total allowed on raft by 50% (from 4 people to 2 people), allowing only those from the same family on raft and still maintaining social distancing.

Temporarily Out of Service:

- Cargo net over lily pads
- Kickboards
